We will be focusing on fluency, reasoning and problem solving.

Ways you can help your child with their maths: Make sure that your child knows their times tables. They should know their 2s, 5s and 10s and now focusing on their 3s, 4s and 8s.

English Curriculum

This term we will be focussing on:

- Genre: Fiction, Non-fiction and Performance poetry
- Grammar: Nouns, adjectives, verbs and tenses
- Spellings: Year 3 statutory spelling list
- Reading list: Who killed Tutankhamun, Storm, Forgotten fairy tales of brave and brilliant girls
- Ways you can help your child with their reading: Ensure they are reading for 20 minutes, daily. Please note that there will be no school diaries this year, we will keep a record of children's reading.





Foundation & Science

In History and Geography we will be studying:

- Ancient Egypt, Cradles of Civilisation, Mountain Ranges and Rivers

In RE we will be learning about:

- Why do we pray?
- Why are festival important

In Science we will investigate and report on:

- Plants (Autumn 1) Rocks (Autumn 2)

Other subjects



- Your child has 2 hours of PE each week, which is delivered by the class teacher, following the Enfield Scheme of Work.
- Our Modern Foreign Language is French
- Computing will focus on Internet Safety and Systems & Networks
- Art and Design will focus on Firs Farm's 70th Birthday Celebrations and Gestural Drawing using Charcoal
- Music will be following Charanga music scheme
- PSHE will focus on Being me in my world and Celebrating differences.

Weekly homework is:


- Math homework is set on My Maths every Friday.

Recorders



We are delighted to let you know that Year 3 will be learning to play the recorder in the Autumn and Spring terms as part of their Music curriculum.

They will be taught by a teacher from the Enfield Music Service.

It is compulsory that your child has a recorder for the lessons, and this can be bought through the school.

We have been able to negotiate a special price of just £2.50 per recorder.

Recorder lessons will begin **this week!** (w/c Monday 16th September)
