#### ENGLISH CURRICULUM

- Genre: Fiction, Non-fiction and poetry
- Grammar: Nouns, adjectives, verbs and tenses (introducing perfect tense)
- Spellings: Year 4 statutory spelling list
- We will be reading: The Spiderwick Chronicles, The Happy Prince, texts linked to The Romans and Black History.

Ensure they are reading daily for 20 minutes.




#### MATHS CURRICULUM

This term we will be focussing on:

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Area
- Multiplication and Division
  We will be focusing on fluency, reasoning and problem solving.

Ways you can help your child with their maths:

Support them in learning all their times tables! (National test in June)



### FOUNDATION & SCIENCE



In History and Geography we will be studying:

•The Roman Republic, the Roman Empire and The Rhine & Mediterranean.

In RE we will be learning about:

•How do family life and festivals show what matters to Jewish people; What it means to be Christian in Britain today.

In Science we will investigate and report on:

 States of Matter (solids, liquids, gases) and Animals including Humans.

### OTHER SUBJECTS



PE is delivered by the class teacher, following the Enfield Scheme of Work;

Our Modern Foreign Language is French and is delivered by Mme D;

Computing will focus on internet safety and word processing.

Our DT focus this term is on designing and building a birthday cake for the schools 70<sup>th</sup> birthday!

Music will look at a song on bullying and using the glockenspiel. Children will also be continuing their recorder lessons.

PSHE will focus on family and friendships, staying safe and respecting ourselves and others.

#### PE DAYS



#### Our PE days are **Wednesday and Thursday**

Please ensure your child has their **full** PE Kit with them at all times. This should include:

- Black shorts

- Jogging bottoms for colder weather NO cotton leggings or cycling shorts
- Plain black trainers (no brands)
- For safety reasons children should have long hair tied back and no jewellery during these lessons.

### SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please remember that our school uniform is:

- Maroon sweatshirt
- Maroon fleece (for outdoor wear only)
- Grey skirt or pinafore
- Grey or black trousers
- Black leggings are allowed underneath skirts/pinafores
- Plain white, black or grey socks or tights
- Boots are not allowed indoors. Shoes should be black and appropriate for school. Trainers with black soles are allowed.
- Long hair should be tied back at all times
- Children should not wear jewellery except for watches (not smart watches) and small studs in pierced ears.
