- Black trainers and shoes are allowed to be worn in school.
- Long hair should be tied back at all times
- Children should not wear jewellery except for watches (not smart watches) and small studs in pierced ears.

We are a no phones school.


In exceptional circumstances, if you feel that your child needs a phone for when they walk home, then a request needs to sent to Mrs Husband who will discuss the requirements with you.

## Maths Curriculum




This half-term we will be focusing on:

- Place value to seven digits.
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division

Ways you can help your child with their maths: regular practise of times tables, access to MyMaths as well as real-life mathematics (e.g. reading the time, working out change in a shop).
