#### **Class Behaviour Systems**

- In our school we celebrate and promote positive behaviour.
- ▶ We use the UNICEF Rights Respecting Charter to promote this.
- Our class behaviour system is Class Dojo.
- Last year we introduced our core Values: Kindness, Excellence, Respect, Togetherness- which we link to our Rights Respecting system.
- We celebrate good behaviour by using praise, Dojos, stickers, Star of the Week, special jobs, Happy Book assemblies, Headteacher Awards.
- Our sanctions could include: discussion with adult about unwanted behaviour during playtime; working individually, away from their peers in class; working in a parallel class; Sad Book; talking to parents.
- Children can also gain House Points and the House with most points is announced each week in Assembly.

# Reading

Children will be given a new **library sharing book weekly**- this is for sharing with the children and will come home on a Friday and be due back the following Friday. Please read the book with your child/children and discuss any unfamiliar words; ask questions about the text and use it for drama activities.

Children also bring home their **reading practice book**- this is a celebration book, so children should be able to read it fluently and talk about it. This comes home on a Friday and is due back on Monday. We continue our new scheme- Little Wandle. Follow the link for parental support with our new phonics scheme:

Ways you can help your child with their reading: listen to him/ her read daily; share a book; discuss what you have read; visit the Library.

# English Curriculum

This term we will be focussing on:

- > Phonics- we will continue to use Little Wandle to catch up with learning.
- We will be reading: stories, instruction texts, poetry and legends, using both fiction and non-fiction books.
- Punctuation: starting sentences with capital letters and ending with . ? ! and using commas for lists in sentences.
- Grammar: using adjectives creatively, starting to use adverbs and understanding the vocabulary for grammar.
- Spellings: we continue to revise the Phase 3 to Phase 5 sounds; after that children will move on to suffixes and prefixes and spelling patterns. They should practise their spellings daily at home and be tested weekly in school, on a Friday. No need to return the spelling worksheet. When Teams are up and running, please upload a photo of the sentences children write.
- Handwriting: we use PenPals for Handwriting. Presentation is very important and we start to join our letters.

## Maths Curriculum

This term we will be focussing on:

- Understanding place value
- Addition
- Subtraction
- Shape

We will use concrete equipment, then representations (drawings) and final abstract (which is using digits).

Ways you can help your child with their maths: learn their 2,5 and 10 times tables in and out of sequence, and start on the other times tables; number bonds to 10, 20, 50 and 100; real-life experiences: using money, measuring, counting, finding shapes in the environment;

#### Foundation & Science

Our topics this half term include:

- Science: Living things and their Habitats, Growing up and taking care
- History and Geography: Remembrance and WW1, Local Study
- PSHE: Well-being, mindfulness and growth mindset, focus on values
- Art TOP: Henry Rousseau 'A Tiger in A Tropical Storm'
- RE: Islam and Judaism
- Computing: E-safety, Internet and Networks, Word processing
- Music and PE linked to our Harvest Festival Assembly


#### PE

#### **PE Days**

Please ensure your child <u>comes to school</u> in their full PE Kit.

This should include:

- Black shorts or jogging bottoms for colder weather (no Leggings or cycling shorts)

- School jumper or sweatshirt (maroon)
- Plain black trainers (limited branding)
- For safety reasons children should have long hair tied back and no jewellery during these lessons.

#### School Uniform
