Thank you to all those who attended our recent presentations on the Year 6 school journey for next year. This is an exciting opportunity that your children have for next academic year.

I have already met with the Year 5 children to talk about the trip and answer any questions they may have so you may well find that your children already have some idea of whether they want to go in Year 6 next year but feel free to share the parent presentation with them if you would like to discuss the trip before then.

Our year 6 children loved this year's journey – the challenges, the teamwork skills they developed and generally how much fun was had on the trip.

Booking is via Arbor, in the usual way for trips - 'Trips open for your child' and then 'Residential trip in Year 6: PGL Bawdsey Manor'. This will be open from 7pm this evening until 9am on Wedneday 16th October.

An initial deposit of £50 (non-refundable) secures a place for the trip. The final cost of the trip is expected to be close to £291 (please see the link to the pdf given above for full information).

There are enough reserved spaces for all Year 5 children to attend, should they wish to do so, but bookings must be made before 16th October to confirm numbers. Pupils wanting to join the trip after the cut-off date will be put on a waiting list.
